Alice Fleck's Recipes for Disaster by Rachelle Delaney

1. If you were taking part in a cooking competition, what dish would you make to impress the judges?
2. Alice's dad tells a story about Marie-Antoine Carême, a young chef from the 1700s who became famous for his incredible pastry sculptures. If you were to make a pastry sculpture, what would you make? Try drawing it!
3. When Alice finds out she'll be competing in a cutthroat reality TV cooking series, she's terrified. How would you feel if you were in her place? Could you handle being on a reality TV show? Why or why not?
4. What were some of the themes in *Alice Fleck's Recipes for Disaster*, and what themes resonate most with you?
5. Tavi believes in ghosts, while Henry is certain they don't exist. What do you think, and why?
6. Which characters in *Alice Fleck's Recipes for Disaster* did you like the most and the least, and why?
7. If you were casting the movie version of this book, who would you choose as the actors?
8. If you got one chance to ask Rachelle Delaney one question about *Alice Fleck's Recipes for Disaster*, what would it be?

Terms of Loan

- All items are checked out to one member's card.
