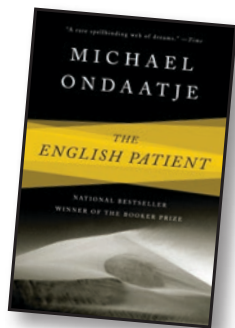
There are so many wonderful things happening at the CLMA and around Clarington, I hope you check them out!

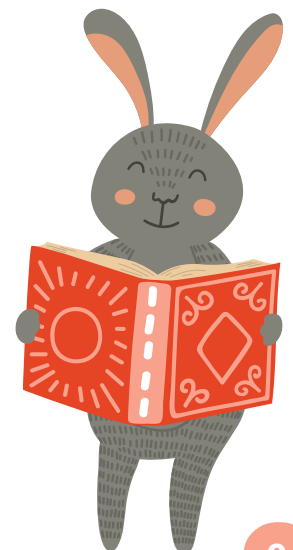

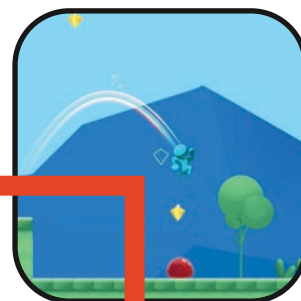
