Mobile App

Let's Get Started!

- Download and open the free **PressReader** app.
- Tap on **Get Started**.
- Select your preferences for **Categories** and **Publications**.
- At the **Sign In** page, select **Libraries & Groups**.
- Tap **Select Library or Group**, type Clarington, and select Library – Clarington Public Library (Offsite).
- Enter your entire 14-digit Clarington Public Library card number and PIN and select **Sign In**.
- **Please note:** You may be required to create a PressReader account to use the mobile app. Sign up for a PressReader account with your email address and name, and click **Sign In**.

Searching for Publications

- Use the **Browse** tab to browse publications or search for a title. In this tab, you will find recommended and popular publications.
- Tap the magnifying glass ("**Search Publications**") along the upper bar and enter your keywords, such as title, publisher, or category.
- For more information and to see back issues, tap the **cover**.
- Tap the **download** icon to add an issue to your device.
- Tap **Read** to open the publication on your device.
- To search by **Country of Publication** or **Language of Publication**, select your preference from the drop-down option.

Navigation

Along the bottom bar, select from **For You**, **Browse**, **Downloaded**, **Bookmarks**, and **More**:

- **For You:** Publications based on your choosing, from preferred newspapers and magazines, to interests that you have selected.
- **Browse:** Recommended and popular publications, as well as the option to "Search Publications" for desired titles or interests.
- **Downloaded:** Read publications on the go! Downloaded newspapers and magazines will appear here.
- **Bookmarks:** Create collections ("Read later") and add titles and articles for later browsing.
- **More:** Access the HotSpot Map, Accounts, and Settings.

Tips & Tricks

- Read in Page or Text View:
 - In Page View, articles will appear as a full-page publication. Zoom in and out to read articles or click on the title of any article to be brought to Text View.
- Translate your publications into different languages (where available) by selecting "Translate".
- Select the headphones to listen to articles (where available).
- Change the font size and brightness by selecting the feature along the bottom bar of any article.

Web Browser

Let's Get Started!

- Visit www.pressreader.com.
- Click on **Sign In**.
- Select **Library or Group** and search for Clarington and select Library – Clarington Public Library (Offsite).
- Enter your entire 14-digit Clarington Library card number and PIN and select **Sign In**.
- **Optional:** Sign up for a PressReader account with your email address and name, and click **Sign In**. Skip this step by clicking “No, thanks” and enjoy reading the full catalogue without an account.

Searching for Publications

- Click on the magnifying glass (“**Search Publications**”) in the upper right-hand corner and enter your keywords, such as title, publisher, or category.
- For more information and to see back issues, tap the **cover**.
- Select **Read Now** to open the publication in your web browser.

Navigation

Along the left side of your browser, select from **Language & Region**, **For You**, **Publications**, **Sections**, and **Interests**:

- **Language & Region:** Select publications in different languages from countries around the world to appear in your Top Stories.
- **For You:** Find your News Feed, as well as popular publications and recommendations.
- **Publications:** Curate a list of chosen publications to follow.
- **Sections:** Find sections of publications to appear in your News Feed.
- **Interests:** Choose from an extensive list of interests to help curate.
